Dear Residents of Jordan Shore Drive,

I am writing to advise you that I will be requesting funds at <u>next year's</u> town meeting to completely reclaim and re-pave your roadway. In our 5-year Paving Plan, it would fall into summer of 2009.

The reason that I am writing so early is because 1) I'd like to start taking input on what specific areas / problems / concerns should be considered in drafting a work contract for the paver, and 2) I understand that there may be several of you that have rather "unusual" electrical set-ups under the roadway and within culverts, etc.

If you have reason to believe that grinding up of the road and replacement of culverts, etc. may impact your home's various infrastructure items (drainage, electric, water, etc.), we would ask that you take the next twelve months and try to remove / correct any potential road-crossing problems.

One final thought: Please be aware that due to high paving prices (all petroleum products), we have had to curtail some of this year's paving (namely the final surface course on Brown Road and Strout Road). Those items will have to be the first two items funded next year, before we move to Jordan Shore Drive. I will be asking for enough to complete all three items, but can make no guarantees on receiving the support needed (Budget Committee, Town Meeting, etc.).

I hope this advance notice of things to come proves helpful to you and opens a dialogue with the town to discuss issues regarding your road. We welcome you to call us if you wish to consult on any item of concern on Jordan Shore Drive. (PWD, Jim Scott: #998-2570; Town Mgr., Dana Lee: #998-4601)

## WATERSHED WORDS

**ALGAE** Microscopic plants either suspended in water or attached to rocks and other substances. Our landowners are learning how to prevent adding phosphorous to Tripp Lake, which is the nutrient that promotes algae growth.

### DISSOLVED OXYGEN (D.O.) The

amount of oxygen dissolved in the water. The D.O. concentration in water is affected by the water temperature, water quality, and other factors. (Lake monitor, John Laskey, will be taking a certification course this May so he can continue to monitor Tripp's D.O.)

**WATERSHED** A region or area divided by points of high land that drains into a specific water body.
